

2022 – 2023 SENIOR MARQUIS PRODUCTIONS



Mission and Goals

The goal of Senior Marquis Productions is to allow students in grades 6 – 12 an equal opportunity to perform in a musical theater production. It not only offers a place to grow as a triple threat performer and build self-esteem, but focuses on professionalism training first and foremost. Students will be cast in roles after auditions for the spring musical. They will learn and perform different styles of musical theater dance throughout the year. The required courses for Marquis Productions are designed to enhance students' performing experience as well as their skills in all three areas of dancing, singing, and acting. This company also begins the process of instilling professional company "measures" and "tactics" to prepare them for performing professionally.

Required Events

- Perform one full-length musical production on May 6, 2023. (This year is Beauty and the Beast)
- March in the Wildwood Day Parade on September 24, 2022
- Perform at Cheer For Charity at Lafayette High School on Sunday, November 13th, 2022
- Attend the all-day in-house dress rehearsal at DPA a week before the performance date from 10:00AM to 6:00PM.
- Attend the technical/dress rehearsal at the theater (West County YMCA) the night before the performance date from 4:00 to 10:00 PM.
- Perform in all recital shows in June 2023 (including dress rehearsal)

In addition to the above events, there are other highly-encouraged performance opportunities throughout the year.

Age Requirements

- Performers for Senior Marquis Productions must be in grades 6 12 as of September 1, 2022.
- Senior Marquis members must sign up by June 30, 2022.

AUDITIONS

Senior Marquis members will audition near the end of September to determine their specific roles in the spring musical.

Required Fall/Spring Classes

MUST BE REGISTERED for Fall/Spring Classes by SEPTEMBER 1, 2022

- Senior Company Members are required to take:
 - Senior Musical Theater Dance
 - Senior Drama/Voice
 - Ballet or Jazz Class
 - 2 ½ weekly Company Rehearsal on Thursdays (7:00-9:30 PM)
- Senior Company Member are highly encouraged to take:
 - Ballet and Jazz
 - Any other elective classes (Tap, Hip Hop, Tumbling, Contemporary, etc)
- Senior Marquis Boys are only required to take rehearsal class on Thursdays and pay the required fees (monthly performance fee, prop/costume fee). Any additional classes you may elect to take will be billed at the regular DPA tuition schedule.

Students are encouraged to take additional elective classes beyond their required classes to increase technique, help condition, and become a more versatile performer.

Attendance

- Attendance for scheduled rehearsals is required by all performers.
- Students are only allowed **3 EXCUSED** absences each semester of Marguis.
- Absences must be discussed in advance and as soon as possible.
- If missing due to an illness, please email Miss Debbie at dpa.debbie@gmail.com
- Three UNEXCUSED absences will result in being pulled from certain numbers in the show. Students must sign the sign-in sheet for all rehearsals (this includes rehearsals at the theater during show times as well).
- STUDENTS <u>MUST BE</u> OFF BOOK (LINES, DANCES, AND SONGS MEMORIZED) BY THE RETURN OF SPRING BREAK.

Rehearsal Attire

Students are required to wear clothing to dance in at rehearsals. Please have a hair tie with you on dance nights as well. Your hair should be pulled back for dance numbers.

Required Performance Uniform (required to participate in additional performances)

Your **performance leotard and leggings** will be stored in the DPA costume closet throughout the year. This will help us avoid the "I forgot mine at home" excuse on the day of shows or performances.

Approximate cost range: \$100 to \$150

- Performance Leotard
- Performance Leggings
- Appropriate dance shoes as needed
- Black Shorts (for under costumes)
- Nude Leotard (for under costumes)
- Optional Team Jacket (\$100)- ordered at beginning of the year

Fees/Expenses (DPA registration fee of \$35 and regular tuition fees apply for classes.)

- Fees/expenses will be kept to a minimum, but extra incidentals may be incurred throughout the year and may include small costume pieces, transportation, entrance fees to events, etc. Advanced notice will be given and, if needed, payment schedules will be worked out.
- Tuition and the Monthly Performance Fee of \$35 are due on the **FIRST** of each month. Failure to pay may result in removal from the Company.
- A one time Costume Fee of \$75 due February 1st
- A one time Prop Fee of \$25 due February 1st
- Ticket Sales- Each family (not performer) is required to sell 10 Tickets the Musical \$100
 - Each family will be charged for the tickets not sold. (*ie* If you only sell 5, you will be charged for the other 5.)

Rehearsal and Show Protocol (Petites will be assisted by a member of SR Marquis)

- All performers will sign in on the sign-in sheet upon arrival to all rehearsals and shows (this includes weekly Marquis rehearsals).
- Costumes will be assigned prior to the show and must be fully accounted for at the end of dress rehearsals and shows.
 - No performer will be allowed to leave dress rehearsals or shows until each performer's costume pieces, shoes, accessories, etc. are accounted for which can add about 20 minutes onto the night, but it will teach more responsibility, teamwork, and most importantly, train them for the professional world which is the goal of Marquis Productions.
 - To help with these new procedures, each performer will have a personalized laundry basket for tossing his/her costume pieces and shoes in as we go through dress rehearsals/shows to help keep things from getting lost. At the end of the night, the re-hanging of costumes will be easier and less stressful. Performers will leave all costume pieces hung in their costume bag.
 - Performers will leave all hair accessories in a smaller container (to be provided).
 - Performers will leave all shoes needed for shows in their laundry baskets.

Practice Videos

All announcements, music, and videos are posted to the Marquis Band account.

PARENT VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

Parents will be asked to volunteer for the following spots for any given show:

- Concessions
- Costume Crew
- Prop Crew
- Backstage Help (quick-change helpers, organizing baskets and costumes as show progresses, etc.)
- Set-up and Clean-up crews
