Registration starts at 3:00PM - Ballet, Jazz, & Solo Auditions from 3:30 until final solo

DAC MISSION & GOALS

The mission and goals of Danse Arts Company are to allow students an opportunity to perform in public venues in a nurturing environment that not only offers a place to grow as a dancer/performer and build self-esteem, but focuses on professionalism training first and foremost. Dancers will learn and perform different styles of dance throughout the year. DAC is designed to enhance the students' performing experience. This company also instills professional company "measures" and "tactics" to prepare dancers for performing professionally.









GENERAL INFORMATION - ALL LEVELS

- ◆ Two Levels of DAC teams: Junior and Senior
- Both levels pay monthly tuition for required classes
- Grades 3 through 12 as of September 1, 2021
- Perform at various community events throughout the year
- Perform in winter show in January 2022
- Perform in all recital shows in June 2022
- Performance and Practice Uniforms purchased through DPA (range from \$100 \$150)
 - Team Jacket optional (\$100)
- Required rehearsal attire includes leotard, tights, and appropriate dance shoes
- ♦ \$30/month performance fee

JUNIOR DAC REQUIREMENTS

- ◆ AUDITION REQUIRED on April 11 (for experience only) ~ Sign Up for group by May 1
- Grades 3 through 5 as of September 1, 2021
- FALL: Required to take DAC Rehearsal Class on Wednesday (time TBD) in the fall/spring
- Required to take Ballet, and Jazz classes in fall/spring
 - Must register for fall classes by September 1, 2021
- Encouraged to attend Guest Artist Workshop (Date TBD: Fees range from \$100 \$150)
- Attendance rules apply (see DAC Contract on website for details)
 - If absent due to illness, email Miss Ashley.

SENIOR DAC REQUIREMENTS

- ◆ AUDITION REQUIRED on April 11 ~ Sign Up by May 1
- Grades 6 through 12 as of September 1, 2021
- SUMMER: Required to take Ballet, Jazz, one Elective class*, DAC rehearsal class
 - Must register by June 5 ~ Payment due by July 1
- FALL: Required to take DAC Rehearsal Class on Wednesday (time TBD) in the fall/spring
 - ◆ Required to take Ballet, Jazz, and one Elective class* in fall/spring
 - Must register for fall classes by September 1, 2021
- Required to attend Guest Artist Workshop (Date TBD: Fees range from \$100 \$150)
- Attendance rules apply (see DAC Contract on website for details)
 - If absent due to illness, email Miss Ashley.

All DAC company members are encouraged to take more than one elective class beyond their required classes to increase technique, help conditioning, and become more versatile dancers.

DAZZLERS MISSION & GOALS

The mission and goals of the Dazzlers Competition Team are to allow students the opportunity to compete and perform in public venues in a nurturing environment. We offer a place to grow as a dancer/performer and build self-esteem, while focusing on professional training first and foremost. Dancers train throughout the year to develop the skills in a broad range of dance styles with an emphasis on jazz and contemporary as well as tap, musical theater, ballet, lyrical, and improvisation. DPA seeks to create artists as well as technicians.





GENERAL INFORMATION - ALL DAZZLERS

- Four ages of Dazzler teams: Mini, Petite, Junior, and Senior
 - Levels split within groups
- All levels pay monthly tuition for required classes
- All levels have costume fees (range from \$80 \$100 per costume per dance)
- All levels have performance and practice uniforms
 - Purchased through DPA (range from \$100 \$150)
 - Team Jacket optional (\$100)
- All levels have competition fees (range from \$45 \$75 per routine for local comps)
 - National competition fees range from \$75 \$125 per routine (Seniors ONLY)
 - Mini, Petite, and Juniors Optional
 - ◆ 50% of fees due by January 1, 2022 ~ Must be PAID IN FULL by February 1, 2022
- All levels required to perform at various community events throughout the year
- All levels required to perform in June 2022 recitals
- All Dazzlers may compete a solo/duo/trio with director approval (additional fees apply)
- Required rehearsal attire includes leotard, tights, and appropriate dance shoes

MINI DAZZLERS REQUIREMENTS

Head Coach: Maria Schou

- Sign up for group by May 1
- Age 4 years through kindergarten as of September 1, 2021
- Required to take 1 dance class of choice per week
- Attend 30-minute weekly team rehearsal class on **Tuesdays** (Time TBD)
- Learn **one** routine to compete at 3 local competitions
- Attendance rules apply (see Mini Dazzler Contract on website for details)
 - If absent due to illness, email your coach.
- No additional coaching/choreography fees apply

PETITE DAZZLERS REQUIREMENTS

Head Coach: Kaylee Howarth

- Sign up for group by May 1
- Grades 1 through 2 as of September 1, 2021
- Required to take Ballet or Jazz classes each week (Combo Classes are great!)
- Attend one hour weekly team rehearsal class on **Tuesdays** (Time TBD)
- Learn one routine to compete at 4 local competitions
- Attendance rules apply (see Petite Dazzlers contract on website for details)
 - If absent due to illness, email Miss Kaylee.
- \$30/month coaching fee in addition to regular tuition
- Additional \$125 choreography fee

JUNIOR DAZZLERS REQUIREMENTS

Head Coach: Kaylee Howarth

AUDITION REQUIRED on April 11 (for experience only)

- Sign up for group by May 1
- Grades 3 through 5 as of September 1, 2021
- Required to take weekly Ballet, Jazz, and Leaps & Turns classes
- Attend two-hour weekly team rehearsal class on Tuesdays (Time TBD)
- Learn two routines to compete at 4 local competitions and possibly Nationals
- Required to attend Guest Artist workshop
 - (Date TBD: Fees range from \$100 \$150)
- Attendance rules apply (see Junior Dazzlers contract on website for details)
 - If absent due to illness, email Miss Kaylee.
- \$30/month coaching fee in addition to regular tuition
- Additional \$125 choreography fee per routine

^{*}All Dazzlers are encouraged to take more than one elective class beyond their required classes to increase technique, help conditioning, and become more versatile dancers.*

SENIOR DAZZLERS REQUIREMENTS

Head Coach: Traci Borrego

- Audition on April 11 required for placement (commit to dances by May 1)
- Grades 6 through 12 as of September 1, 2021
 - Currently four levels of Senior Dazzlers: Novice, Intermediate, Advanced, Elite

SUMMER REQUIREMENTS

- Required to take Ballet and Jazz classes in addition to Dazzler rehearsal <u>PLUS</u> Production number rehearsal (if participating)
 - Production rehearsals are on **Tuesdays** from 8:45 9:30PM.
 - Summer classes run from June 28 August 5
 - Must register by June 5, 2021
 - Payment due by July 1, 2021

MANDATORY: Attend Choreography Week from August 9 - 13

- Please block 9:00AM 3:00PM for Monday through Friday.
- Each dance will be scheduled to learn choreography this week.
- Be prepared for your dance(s) to be called to rehearse all five days.
- Rehearsals are \$10 per routine per rehearsal.

FALL/SPRING REQUIREMENTS

- Required to take Ballet, Jazz, Leaps & Turns classes <u>plus</u> scheduled **Saturday** rehearsals in the fall/spring.
 - Novice/Intermediate/Advanced dancers rehears <u>every Saturday</u> based on assigned dance(s).
 - Elite dancers rehears <u>every other Saturday</u> based on assigned dance(s).
 - Rehearsal fees are \$10 per rehearsal/dance for each dancer.
- If you compete in a dance style other than ballet or jazz, you must be enrolled in that elective class dance style. (i.e. If you perform hip hop, you must be in a hip hop class.)
- Required to attend Guest Artist Workshop at DPA
 - Date TBD: Fees range from \$100 \$150
- Senior Dazzlers are cast in dances and compete at 6 competitions (5 local, 1 national).
- Required to attend one dance convention in conjunction with one local competition
 - Additional fees for convention apply (range from \$250 \$300)

CHOREOGRAPHY FEES

- Solos/Duets/Trios: Fees range from \$250 \$350 (determined by choreographer)
- Group Dances: <u>Maximum</u> fee of \$62.50 per group routine (4 or more dancers)
- Guest Artist Choreography fees paid directly to Guest Artist and determined by Guest Artist.

COMPETITION FEES (per competition)

- Solos: Fees range from \$100 \$150 (depending on competition)
- Duets/Trios: Fees range from \$45 \$85 per dancer (depending on competition)
- Group Dances: Fees range from \$45 \$80 per dancer (depending on competition)

ATTENDANCE

- OUTSIDE SPORTS do not count as excused absences from rehearsals
- No dancer is allowed to miss the week of a competition unless there is a school event that is part of a grade or a serious contagious illness.
- Two excused absences allowed per semester with written notice in advance.
- If absent due to illness, email your coach.
- Three unexcused absences will result in being pulled from the team.

PETITE & JUNIOR MARQUIS REQUIREMENTS

- Sign up by August 31
- Grades 1 through 5 as of September 1, 2021
- Auditions for roles in spring show are held in October 2021

REQUIRED CLASSES FOR FALL/SPRING

- PETITE (Grades 1 & 2)
 - Required to take Kids Musical Theater Dance
 - Encouraged to take a Ballet or Jazz class
 - 30-minute company rehearsals on Thursdays (Time TBD)
- JUNIOR (Grades 3 5)
 - Required to take Youth Musical Theater Dance & Youth Drama/Voice
 - Encouraged to take a Ballet or Jazz class
 - 60-minute company rehearsals on Thursdays (Time TBD)

REQUIRED EVENTS

- Perform in full-length musical in May 2022
- Attend all-day dress rehearsal at DPA from 10:00AM to 6:00PM in May 2022
- Attend one technical/dress rehearsal at theater in May 2022 from 4:00 10:00PM
- Perform in all recital shows in June 2022 including dress rehearsal
- Perform at various community events throughout the year

ADDITIONAL FEES

- \$30 Monthly Performance Fee (in addition to regular tuition)
- Performance and Team Uniforms purchased through DPA (range from \$100 \$150)
 - Team Jacket optional ~ \$100
- Extra incidentals may be incurred (costumes, props, etc.)
 - Advanced notice will be given

ATTENDANCE

- Three excused absences allowed per semester with written notice in advance

- Attend one technical/dress rehearsal at theater in May 2022 from 4:00 10:00PM
- Perform in all recital shows in June 2022 including dress rehearsal
- Perform at various community events throughout the year
