Competitions & BAND App Use

During competitions & events, we rely exclusively on our BAND group for communication; this ensures that all teachers, dancers, and parents are on the same page and can assist each other quickly. Similarly, the BAND app is the only platform that sends notifications directly to our faculty's phones; we won't see other notifications. Using BAND helps us ensure that any questions are seen by the whole team, and everyone can pitch in to help out fellow dancers and parents. We'll provide all the information you need in advance, and BAND will be our main way to stay connected and organized during the busy competition days!

Purpose and Values of our Dazzler Competition Team:

At Devine Performing Arts, our competition team is a testament to our commitment to excellence in dance and personal growth. The purpose of this team is to allow dancers to grow into their own artistry and performance, as well as provide an opportunity to obtain the best possible training and technique. Dancers will have the opportunity to learn and compete choreography in a variety of styles including ballet, jazz, contemporary, tap, hip hop, and more throughout the season. The required courses for the Dazzlers are designed to enhance the students' performing experience as well as their technical skills. It not only offers a place to grow as a dancer/performer and build self esteem, but focuses first and foremost on professionalism.

Qualities We Seek In Team Members:

We are looking for dedicated dancers aged 5-18 as of September 1, 2025 who are eager to be a part of our competition team. These artists demonstrate a strong work ethic, a willingness to learn, and a passion for dance. We value team-oriented individuals who are motivated by both personal and collective success, and who bring a positive, inclusive attitude to every rehearsal and performance. Our team members are expected to be committed to their dance education and embrace the opportunity to mentor younger dancers, helping to create a nurturing environment that cultivates leadership and artistic growth. If you have a desire to push your limits and thrive in a professional, supportive dance community, we invite you to join us in this exciting journey!

What To Expect:

At Devine Performing Arts, we hold ourselves to high standards, and we expect our dancers to rise to them. When you step into our studio, you're leaving the outside world at the door. Whatever happened that day, let it go. You're here to learn, grow, and immerse yourself in the joy of dance. Our studio is a place for you to pursue your passion with focus, determination, and artistry.

Bring your best energy to every class. This means working hard, being open to corrections, showing up on time, and coming prepared. We understand that it's not always easy to stay motivated, but that's why we're here—to guide you, push you, and support you through the tough times. Your teachers, your peers, and your parents are all in this together to encourage you every step of the way.

Our team has big goals, and reaching them requires commitment and effort. We don't settle for half-hearted attempts or giving up when things get tough. We provide you with the tools—both physical and mental—to help you reach your fullest potential. Some days will be hard, exhausting, and you might wonder why you're pushing yourself so much. You'll realize just how strong you are and understand that this mindset can help you achieve whatever goals you have in life. Team Policies

Joining the Team:

Ages 5-7: All of the dazzlers ages 5-7 are required to compete in one group dance. Our members of Kids Dazzlers have the option to add a second dance (group/trio/duo) should they like to. Solos are also allowed and are based on the dancer's readiness, which is determined by the coaches.

Ages 8+: All of the dazzlers ages 8+ are required to compete in one group dance at minimum before adding any trios/duos/solos. The coaches will cast you accordingly for any and all dances. For solos you are allowed to request what style you'd like and who you would like to choreograph it. Your requests are taken into consideration and we do our best to accommodate them, but there are no guarantees. Whatever you select on your audition form is what you are committing to. You cannot change your mind after casting comes out. We base our dances off of those forms and expect you to follow through.

For Dancers:

At Devine Performing Arts, we believe that respect, positivity, and professionalism are fundamental to our success. As a dancer, you are expected to embody these values at all times. Treat your teammates, faculty, and competitors with kindness and respect, and approach every class, rehearsal, and performance with dedication and a positive attitude. Come prepared with the proper attire and materials, and be punctual and ready to participate fully. We are a drama-free studio, and we do not tolerate gossip, negativity, or speaking ill of others. Our focus is on building a supportive, inclusive environment where everyone can thrive and grow as artists.

For Parents:

Parents play a crucial role in supporting our dancers and contributing to a positive studio environment. We expect parents to communicate respectfully with faculty and other parents and to address any issues directly and constructively. Your involvement in your dancer's journey is vital, and we ask that you ensure they adhere to the attendance policy and participate fully in team activities. Parents are also expected to model good sportsmanship and a cooperative spirit, supporting all team members and contributing to a drama-free atmosphere. Lift up and support all our artists, teach your child the value of perseverance and work ethic, and encourage a team-oriented mindset.

Commitment to Regular Attendance:

Regular attendance is essential for the success of our team. Dancers are expected to attend all scheduled classes, rehearsals, and performances. Consistent participation is key to team cohesion and individual progress. While we understand that occasional absences may occur, frequent absences will hinder a dancer's ability to perform effectively and grow as a dancer, which may impact their eligibility for performances. We ask that all absences be communicated to the faculty in advance (at least 1 week) to allow for proper planning and adjustments.

Procedure for Reporting Absences:

If a dancer is unable to attend a class or rehearsal, please notify Miss Ashley via email as soon as possible. For planned absences, advance notice is required. In the case of illness or emergencies, please inform us immediately. A doctor's note may be required for prolonged absences due to illness to ensure that the dancer is safe to return to training. Your dancer plays an integral role in our team, and their attendance affects their entire team.

Class Attendance:

To ensure continuity in training, dancers are required to attend make-up classes for any required classes that they miss more than one of each month. Make-up classes should be scheduled within the next month; this helps dancers stay on track with the team's progress and ensures they do not fall behind in their training. If a dancer must miss a class, try to make it an elective.

Rehearsal Attendance:

If your dancer misses rehearsal, it is their responsibility to get caught up before the next rehearsal. Private lessons are strongly encouraged or may be required depending on how many rehearsals they've missed. Missing too many rehearsals could result in your dancer being pulled from certain pieces in the next competition. Your dancer's progress and their impact on the team are our top priorities.

Competition Attendance:

Attendance at all scheduled competitions is mandatory. We rely on every dancer's participation to represent The Dazzlers with excellence and pride. Moreover, our dancers work incredibly hard to put their best foot forward at competitions, and just one dancer's absence hurts the entire team. Absences from these events will be taken seriously and may result in removal of the dancer's placement on our team. Dazzlers age 10 and under are excused after 8pm.

Competition Attire/Team Uniform

Dancers are expected to have the following required items:

- Performance Teams T-Shirt
- Performance Leggings
- Team Earrings
- Appropriate Undergarments
- All Appropriate Dance Shoes (Jazz shoes ordered through DPA)
- Performance Tights (Ordered through DPA)
- All Costumes and Costume Pieces
- All Hair and Make Up Products
- DPA Team Jacket (\$150 and optional)

Rehearsal and Competition Protocol:

- All rehearsal videos and information will be posted to the Dazzler Band account.
- Rehearsal/Performance Videos and/or Photos are NEVER to be posted to any social media accounts.
- There is absolutely no cell phone use allowed during rehearsal time (unless otherwise stated by the rehearsal director). Cell phones are to stay in bags and/or backpacks until dancers have a significant break.
- Competition schedules are not received until 1 - 2 weeks prior to the event.
 - You must reserve the entire weekend (Friday - Sunday and sometimes Thursday).
 - Please do not ask Debbie or Ashley if they have the schedule yet. You will receive it once they do.
- Dancers must arrive ready to dance two hours prior to their scheduled performance time ready to go.
 - This allows time to warm up and review.
 - Competitions rarely run on time so we need to be prepared to perform early (or late).
 - Schedule updates will be posted in the Dazzler Band throughout the weekend.
- All Dazzlers are required to be present for all DPA performances, however Dazzlers age 10 and under will be excused by 8:00pm.
- Dazzlers only need to be present for awards they performed in unless otherwise requested.

Social Media Presence:

Dazzlers must use good judgment in using social media. Don't post anything you wouldn't be okay with your grandparents seeing. Inappropriate posts will result in a warning, and if inappropriate posts continue the dancer could be terminated from the team.

Removal from the Team:

Respect must be shown to all instructors, dancers, parents, and guests at all times.

- Poor attitudes will not be tolerated—not in the classroom and certainly not at outside events.
- Being disrespectful or rude to the choreographer, rehearsal director, parents, other team members, and other competitors is absolutely unacceptable.
- One warning will be given to the dancer and the parent before that dancer is suspended.
 - If behavior is poor enough, the first warning will not be given and the dancer will be terminated from the team.
 - Grounds for immediate termination include physical violence, bullying of any kind, and not showing up for an event.
 - There will be no refunds on performance fees, tuition, or costume fees.

Poor attendance can also cause removal from the team or certain pieces you are performing in.

Resigning From Dazzlers:

- Resigning after signing the Dazzler contract, but before choreography is learned, results in being responsible for the full payment of the following:
 - \$50 per dance administrative fee
- Resigning after choreography is learned, but before the start of the fall season (September 8, 2026) will result in being responsible for the full payment of the following:
 - All Choreography fees
 - \$50 per dance administrative fee
- Resigning after the season has begun (September 8, 2026) results in being responsible for the full payment of the following:
 - All Choreography fees
 - All Competition fees
 - All Costume fees that are not returnable
 - \$50 per dance administrative fee
- Missing a competition for any reason other than emergencies will have financial ramifications.
 - You will be responsible for the full payment of the following:
 - Private lesson fees to the choreographer to teach the choreography to any replacement dancer
 - Rehearsal fees for any additional rehearsals that need to be held
 - All competition fees that affect the dance(s) you would be missing (ie. group dance changing to trio, etc)
 - \$50 per dance administrative fee

Required Tights:

- *Pink Ballet Tights. Purchase price through the studio is \$10.*

- *Pink Ballet Shoes. Purchase price through the studio is \$20-\$25.*

Required Leotard:

- *Ballet 3/4, Pointe, & Variations: Black or other dark color*

Calendar Information

Technique Intensive: *(required for ages 8+)*

Those 8+ wishing to join the Dazzler Competition Team must attend the Summer Technique Intensive **June 15-19, 2026**. Dancers will take multiple classes in multiple styles each day from 9:30am-3:00pm.

Team Auditions: *(required for ages 8+)*

Company placement auditions for ages 8+ will take place on the final day of the Summer Technique Intensive **June 19th**. Dancers level 1-2 will learn an audition combo in the morning to present in groups of 2-3. Dancers Level 3-5 will learn an audition combo in the morning to present in groups of 2-3 and then will stay to present a 1 minute self choreographed solo.

Summer Classes: *(required for ages 8+)*

Dazzler Members are required to register and pay for the full six-week summer session by the first day of classes **June 22, 2026**. Company members age 8+ are required to take Ballet (2 classes per week if level 3+), Jazz, and Leaps & Turns. Other styles they will be competing are highly encouraged.

Dazzler's age 5-7 are encouraged to take summer classes as well, such as kids combo.

Students are encouraged to take additional elective classes beyond their required classes to increase technique, help condition, and become more versatile performers.

Choreography Week: *(required for ages 8+)*

Dazzlers age 8+ are required to attend the choreography intensive **August 10-13, 2026**. Dancers will be scheduled for specific blocks based on what dances they will be learning. **ALL** dances will be learned during this time. Dazzlers age 5-7 will learn their dances at the beginning of the new season.

Season Classes: *(required for all)*

All Dazzler Members are required register and pay by the first day of classes **September 8, 2026**. Company members ages 8+ are required to take Ballet (2 classes per week if level 3+), Jazz, Leaps & Turns, and any elective classes they will be competing *(if they compete hip hop, they must take hip hop)*. Company members age 7 are required to take ballet and jazz, while ages 5-6 are required to take kids combo. All kids Dazzlers are required to take the Dazzler technique class on Saturday mornings before their rehearsal.

Students are encouraged to take additional elective classes beyond their required classes to increase technique, help condition, and become more versatile performers.

Competitions: *(required for all)*

Dazzler Members are required to participate in all scheduled competitions. Dates will be sent out as soon as we have them finalized (February-May).

Master Class/Convention: *(required for ages 8+)*

Dazzler Members are required attend one convention each season. Tremaine will be **February 27-28, 2027**. We will also be hosting a Master Class day at DPA in October and the Dazzlers are highly encouraged to attend.

Recitals: *(required for all)*

All Dazzler Group Dances will perform in DPA's annual recitals **June 12 & 13, 2027**. All Dazzlers are required to participate. This includes all events related to recital (pictures, dress rehearsal, etc).

DPA Tuition & Fees

Class Tuition

Monthly installments (9 total installments) as listed OR pay each semester in full for a 3% discount.

Full semester payments must be completed by September 8th or January 5th to receive the 3% discount.

Dance cards are excluded from semester discounts.

Details: Summer Tuition is due on the first day of classes.

Choreography Fees

Amount: Determined by number of dances and their group sizes. See chart on previous page.

Due Date: August 10, 2026

Details: Choreography Fees are due on the first day of Choreography Week for ages 8+. Ages 5-7 are due September 8, 2026.

Season Fees

Registration Fee (each fall)

Amount: \$35 for the first dancer and \$30 for each additional dancer.

Due Date: At the time of class registration.

Details: The registration fee must be paid when you register your child for classes to secure their spot in the class.

Season Tuition (monthly)

Amount: Determined by number of classes.

Due Date: The first of each month.

Details: Season Tuition is due on the first day of classes and then on the first of each month through May 2026. If you would like to take advantage of the semester discount, please contact Ashley at dpa.ashley.stettes@gmail.com to arrange this payment. Semester payments are due September 8, 2026 and January 5, 2027.

Rehearsal Fees (monthly)

Amount: Determined by size of competition piece and how many rehearsals you have a month.

Due Date: The first of each month.

Details: TBD based on your dances

Coaching Fees (monthly)

Amount: \$40

Due Date: The first of each month.

Details: Coaching Fees go directly to paying our staff to attend competitions and conventions.

Costume Fees (one per competition dance)

Amount: \$100 - \$125 per costume

Due Date: October 1, 2026

Details: Each Dazzler dance will have it's own costume and costume fee.

Competition Fees (cost per competition)

Amount: Determined by number of dances and their group sizes. See chart on previous page.

Due Date: \$250 deposit due September 8, 2026. 50% by January 5, 2027 with remaining balance paid by February 1, 2027.

Details: Dazzlers are required to attend the competitions selected for the season.

Media Fees for Competitions

Amount: \$35-\$50

Due Date: Included with Competition Fees

Details: Some competitions require a media fee which will give you access to all your photos and videos.

Convention Fee (once)

Amount: \$300-\$400

Due Date: January 5, 2027

Details: Dazzlers are required to attend one convention or master class series. Specific date will be released as soon as possible.

Competition Preparation

Hairstyle

Hairstyles will be determined by the choreographer for each dance.

Make Up

All dancers must wear full make up for all competitions. This includes foundation, neutral eye shadow, black eye liner, black mascara, false eye lashes, rosy blush, and wine lipstick.

Nail Polish

All nail polish must be removed before a performance. The only acceptable colors are nude or french tips for both fingers and toes.

Earrings

All dancers must wear our company earrings. These are available both stud and clip on and can be purchased at the studio for \$10.

Jewelry

All other jewelry must be removed. Think about timeline when planning to get any new piercings.

Tights

Dancers are responsible to bring their competition tights (ordered at the beginning of the season).

Undergarments

Dancers are responsible to bring all appropriate undergarments including nude leotard.

Costumes

Dancers are responsible to bring their costumes and all costume pieces. Their costumes need to be stage ready meaning they are steamed and ready to put on at your call time.

Snacks

Competition days are long! Be sure to pack enough food and water to keep your body in top performance mode.

Call Time Requirements

Dancers are required to be completely ready to perform 2 hours before their scheduled dance time. This gives us time to adequately warm up and rehearse before taking the stage. If dancers are in multiple dances they often times will not have the full 2 hours between performances. This is why it is super important to have everything ready and organized to make changing fast and efficient. When not dancing, you are required to be there 1 hour before your teammates dance time.

Competition Conduct

Parents' role at competitions is to provide encouragement from the audience, supporting their dancer and the entire team! Your positive energy helps create a constructive and uplifting environment. Dancers' role is to demonstrate professionalism, respect their parents, teammates, and teachers, and bring a goal-oriented mindset to the space. They should approach each competition with dedication and positivity, focusing on personal growth and the collective success of the team! Teachers' role is to guide and prepare dancers with a focus on both technical excellence and mental readiness, ensuring they feel confident and capable on stage! We provide structured training, detailed feedback, and encourage open dialogue to address any of the dancers' challenges or concerns. When watching a performance, do not stand up or move around, especially in front of cameras or other audience members, as this can obstruct parents' views and disturb the photos/videos.
